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






High School Curriculum Scope & Sequence



Overview

This **High School Scope and Sequence** is designed for Art 1 and 2 classes, focusing on drawing skills, self-expression, and design. Lessons are sequenced to build one skill at a time, helping students form strong habits and routines. Depending on your course length, you may only get through some projects or reserve advanced lessons for upper-level classes. I usually end with shading in Art 1 and continue the sequence in Art 2.



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

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Negative Space Drawing










Before shading, it's beneficial to introduce lessons on Negative Space to help students familiarize themselves with observing the areas between shapes when drawing realistically.

Line Drawing and Scaling an Image



This Neuro Doodle lesson is highly popular among students as it helps them gain confidence with lines and learn how to scale their drawings, preparing them for realistic drawing in the future.

Neon Lights





You have the option to do one or both of these activities. The oil pastel version can either stand alone or be used as a warm-up for the painting. Student's learn about design and value.

Shading Practice



These worksheets are crucial for mastering shading techniques before starting the subsequent shading projects.

Celtic Knot Drawing



Students create celtic knots and practice simple shading skills.







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


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Shading Graphite










You can choose any or all of these shading lessons. These should be completed AFTER the shading worksheets. The geometric shape lesson is the most simple.

Shading Charcoal



Students will apply their knowledge of value and shading in a different medium.

Reverse Value Shading







Begin with the sphere and end with the instruments. The images get progressively more complex.

Black and White on Toned Paper





You can choose one of these, complete both, or offer students a choice of either the butterfly or chain.

Pen and Ink Drawing/Texture







You can choose one of these, complete all of the lessons, or offer students a choice.

Charcoal Portraits















Students will begin by practicing facial features using the worksheets and then complete the final portrait drawing.





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
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Colored Pencil








Students learn about color theory and how to implement their understanding of value within color. You have the option to select one or all of these projects.

This is a fun simple watercolor project to get students using color and value in a new medium.

Acrylic Painting



This is a small scale painting project that teaches color mixing and helps students get comfortable using acrylics.
